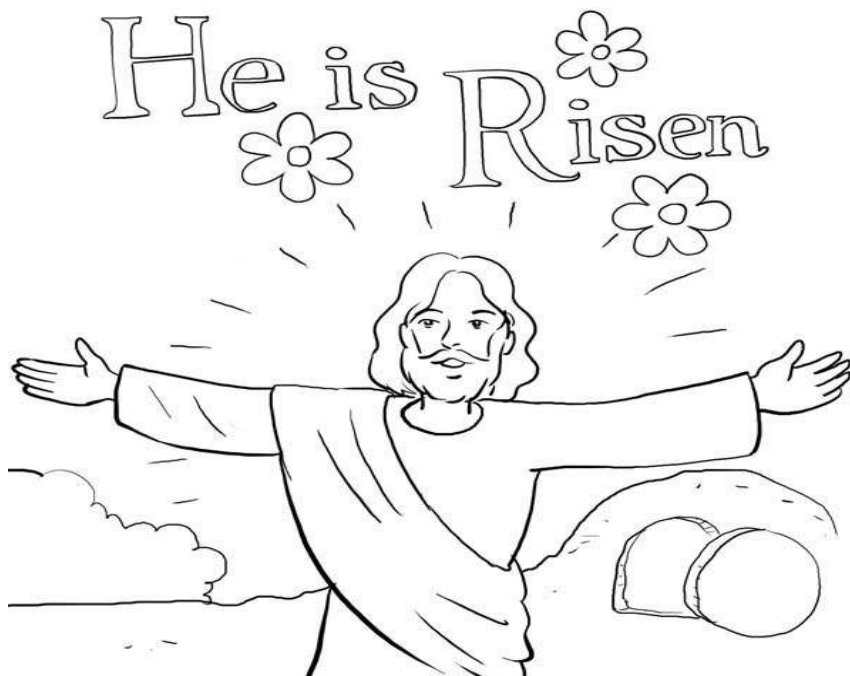

MENTAL HEALTH SPOTLIGHT

PERFECTIONISM VS STRIVING FOR EXCELLENCE

Perfectionism is a personality trait, or a set of beliefs and behaviors characterized by the relentless pursuit of high standards, an intense fear of making mistakes, and the need for flawless performance in various aspects of life. It involves setting exceedingly high and often unrealistic standards for oneself and striving to meet these standards at all costs. While aiming for excellence can be positive, perfectionism takes this pursuit to an unhealthy extreme.

Healthy Striving for Excellence looks like:

- Setting standards that are high but within reach
- Enjoying the process as well as outcome
- Bouncing back quickly from failure or disappointment
- Keeping normal anxiety and fear of failure within bounds
- Seeing mistakes as opportunities for growth and learning
- Reacting positively to helpful criticism

It's important to keep in mind that the impact of perfectionism can vary among individuals, and not everyone who exhibits perfectionistic traits will experience severe negative consequences (e.g. rigidity, self-destructive behaviors, and negative impacts on daily functioning). Mental health professionals often work with individuals to address these negative consequences of perfectionism.
