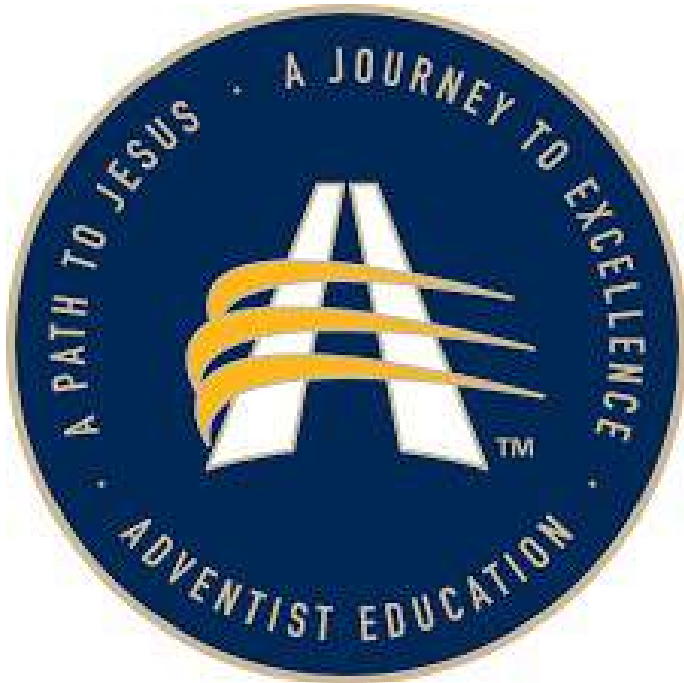

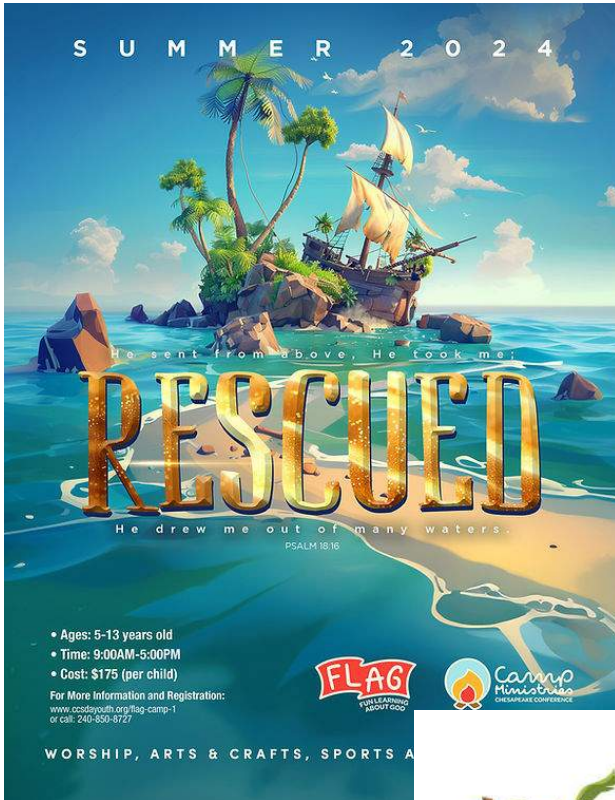

DISCIPLESHIP SPOTLIGHT

Note the following very precise instructions and acknowledgements as Jesus began His model prayer as a Master teacher:

- **Our Father, which is in heaven, Hallowed (or Holy), be thy name.** This first statement is our recognition of who we accept Him to be and the status we offer Him in our lives. *The effectiveness of our faith is based on who He is to us.* We must acknowledge Him in *spirit and truth because God is not mocked!*
- **Thy kingdom come, thy Will be done on earth, as it is done in heaven.** We must recognize the success of the plan of Salvation. He has offered us reconciliation through Jesus Christ's victory on the Cross and His authority over us. We acknowledge there is only one God, (The Trinity), who rules both heaven and earth with one set of immutable laws, natural and moral; which governs through Love, in the heavens and on the earth.
- **Give us this day our daily bread.** This is not just a prayer designed for Christians; *it is the prayer for all humanity.* It is God alone who has the power, the willingness and the love for His creation, to provide us bread to sustain our physical being and breath to maintain life. He alone is also the source who provides the spiritual bread of life to make us whole; for humans are both physical and spiritual beings and do not live by physical bread only; but by spiritual bread as well; which is the Word of God. The term "our daily bread" refers to both physical and spiritual bread.
- **And forgive us our debts; as we forgive our debtors.** By asking for forgiveness, we recognize our dependence as sinners who are unable to cleanse ourselves from sin. We also promise to forgive those who offend us in the manner and willingness, as we are forgiven. If we expect to be forgiven we must be ready and willing to forgive those who offend us. This is how we keep our "thinking" free of unrighteous thoughts. Sinning begins with an unrighteous thought. It is with our thoughts we first commit sin and we renew in our minds to live in righteousness.
- **And lead us not into temptations.** God does not lead us into temptations but Satan does. However, we are asking to be led away from the temptations we encounter, even when we may be responsible for encouraging those temptations by indulging in practices that are inappropriate for the Christian lifestyle. God often allows us to meet temptations so we may learn to overcome and thereby strengthen our faith. Even Jesus was allowed to experience the challenge of temptation.
- **But deliver us from evil.** Satan is like "a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour" and temptations often overtake us before we are fully aware. So we need to pray to be delivered from these before they occur and we are destroyed. Our prayer must include the request to overcome temptations. Jesus understands that like Eve, we may not be seeking temptation but the tempter's deceptions are too subtle for us and ensnares us before we are aware.

For thine is the kingdom the power and the glory forever. We end our petition with the acknowledgement that God rules in our lives as well as He rules in the entire cosmos. His rule is inevitable. Those who contest His authority will not prevail. Satan will be as ashes upon the earth; his rebellion will end in oblivion. The battle was already won at the Cross of Calvary; so we have the assurance that we are already victorious. Amen.
