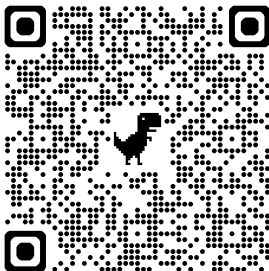

Welcome

Church family,

As we watch headlines fill with conflict—nation against nation and rumors of war—many hearts feel unsettled. But Jesus spoke to times like these with both honesty and tenderness. He said, “You will hear of wars and threats of wars, but don’t panic” (Matthew 24:6). Then He explained that these events are “birth pains” (Matthew 24:8)—real, intense, and sometimes frightening, but also proof that God’s story is moving toward a promised new beginning.

So today I want to remind you: we are not called to panic; we are called to trust. Nothing taking place has surprised our Lord. The world may feel unstable, but Jesus remains steady. He has already seen the road ahead, and He walks it with His people.

Christ is not only preparing an ending—He is preparing a people. And in the middle of these “birth pains,” He is shaping His church into a safe space: a community where faith is strengthened, burdens are shared, tears are met with compassion, and hope is spoken louder than fear. The world may grow harsher, but the church must grow warmer. The times may grow darker, but God is calling us to shine brighter.
